DAY 01 SINGAPORE - TAOYUAN (MOB)

Assemble at Singapore Changi International Airport for your flight to **Taipei**.

Transfer to your hotel.

DAY 02 TAOYUAN - RUIFANG - TAICHUNG (B)

• Jiufen

You will find famous local delights such as taro and sweet potato balls etc at this old mining town. It is also the filming site of 'City of Sadness'.

• Shifen Station

The place where sky lantern originates. Have your wishes written on the Sky Lanterns and release it for good luck and blessings.

Note: 4-6 pax to 1 lantern

• Gaomei Wetland

The Wetland covers a vast expanse of 1500 hectares with an amazing rich biodiversity to explore.

• Feng Chia Night Market

The city's largest and most popular night market providing an assortment of shops to browse through for food, clothing, games entertainment and most notably, plenty of local snacks to please every palate.

DAY 03 TAICHUNG - CHANGHUA - YUNLIN - CHIAYI (B/L)

• The Manatee Experience

It's the hometown of the pearl oysters. There are interesting guides for sightseeing, which you get to experience the manatee car, digging the sand to pick up clams, catch little crabs and taste the fresh and delicious oysters.

Roam the street that is famed for its well preserved cultural and historical heritages.

• Wenhua Night Market

Sample all kinds of local snacks and delicacies.

DAY 04 CHIAYI - NANTOU (B/L/D)

• Puli Brewery

You may wish to purchase the high quality Shaoxing rice wine directly from the brewery.

• Aboriginal Local Product Centre

Shop for the 3 treasures of Taiwan - the wild Ling Zhi, Japanese deer related and Royal Jelly products.

• Cingjing

Evergreen Grassland is where you get to see herds of sheep grazing on the land and the azure skies make you want to stay a little longer.

DAY 05 NANTOU - MIAOLI - TAIPEI (B/L/D)

• Cingjing Skywalk

It is about 1700~2000m above sea level and 1.2 km long.

• Miaoli Arwin Rose Forest

The area is painted with Orange Jessamine and Roses. Spot the century-old Orange Jessamine King!

• Jinshan Old Street

Reminisce the area's past heydays and savor the tastes from an earlier time. Do not leave without bringing home the bite sized pastries and sesame pastries.

• Hot Spring Hotel

Get ready for a hot spring experience.

DAY 06 TAIPEI (B/L)

• North Coast Scenic Area (Photo stop)

• Tamsui Fisherman's Wharf

The major landmark is the Lovers' Bridge. Besides, there is also a boardwalk and riverside cafes, a shopping street and art street filled with creative souvenirs.

• Tamsui Old Street

Take a walk down Tamsui Old Street. You may try the local street food that are unique to Tamsui such as A Gei iron eggs, fish crackers, fish balls with meat fillings etc.

• Taipei 101

Spend time at the world's second tallest building.

• Vigor Kobo

DIY Pineapple Cake experience.

• Dadaocheng

This fascinating neighborhood is where you can see how Taipei Old Town meets modern innovation. The main streets of Dadaocheng and Dihua Streets are filled with artsy boutiques, tea houses, fabric stores, souvenir shops, traditional market, trendy coffee shops, art galleries. Don't leave the place without trying the local Taiwanese cuisine.

• Tian Lu Arts Centre

A Chinese mythical hybrid creature. Displaying Tian Lu at home or in the office is believed to prevent wealth from flowing away.

• Ximending

Otherwise called "Harajuku" of Taipei, this pedestrian shopping paradise is one of the city's culture centers, hosting a massive variety of fashion clothing shops, eclectic restaurants and so forth.
