## Day 01 Singapore > Istanbul, Turkiye

Meals on Board

Assemble at Changi Airport for your flight to **Istanbul, Turkiye**

## Day 02 Istanbul > Bursa

Lunch, Dinner

- Proceed to **Bursa City Centre**, which has a historical significance as the first capital of the Ottoman Empire
- **Green Mosque Mausoleum**, a complex consists of a mosque, a mausoleum known as the Green Tomb, a madrasa, a public kitchen, and a bathhouse
- **Silk Market**, now an upmarket shopping area and cafes. It's been well restored and retains some of its original atmosphere

## Day 03 Bursa > Kusadasi

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

- Enter into the Ancient city of **Ephesus**, one of the best preserved Greco-Roman ancient city in the world today
- Travel back in time and immerse in the mystical atmosphere of the ancient world at **Ephesus Experience Museum**

## Day 04 Kusadasi > Pamukkale

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

- Relish a fashion show at the Leather Outlet Centre and witness the high end quality leather that is available
- Walk through the ruins of the once magnificent city, **Hierapolis**, which was destroyed by earthquakes
- **Cotton Castle**, the famous white limestone travertines, shaped by calcium-rich hot springs that cascades down a steep hill \*Do bring shorts & slippers if you would like to submerge your legs into the hot springs
- Tonight, stay in a thermal spring hotel and get a chance to enjoy the pool that is filled with natural healing water \*Do bring your swimming costume

## Day 05 Pamukkale > Demre > Antalya

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

- You may want to go onto a **Sunken City Boat Tour** and witness the villages of Kalekoy, Ucagiz and ruins of several ancient Lycian villages (on own expenses) \*Dependent on weather conditions
- Visit the **Demre Town**, situated along the Mediterranean coast, which is also home to Saint Nicholas
- Make a trip to **Santa Claus Museum**, where the esteemed figure of St. Nicholas, known as the inspiration behind Santa Claus, once served as a bishop in Anatolia
- Continue on to the **Myra Ancient City** and notice the **Lycian Rock cut Tombs**, carved all the way back in the 5th century BC

## Day 06 Antalya > Konya > Cappadocia

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

- Do a walking tour in **Antalya** and see the "Hadrianus Triumphal Arch" erected in 130 AD
- **Aspendos Theater**, built in honour of the famous emperor Marcus Aurelius, is one of the best preserved ancient theater till date
- Tonight, you may want to join a lively **Belly Dancing show** that comes together with unlimited drinks (on own expenses)

## Day 07 Cappadocia

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

- This morning, you may want to go for an experience on the famous hot air balloon and view the magnificent landscape of Cappadocia
- Wanna get up close with the lime stone structures that made up the beautiful sight of Cappadocia, you may opt for the Jeep Safari ride
- Visit the factory to understand why Turkish carpets are well known in the world
- A lovely valley, **Pigeon Valley**, is named after the thousands of pigeons houses carved into the soft tufa rock which offers a spectacular panoramic view
- **Goreme Valley**, a UNESCO World Heritage site with spectacular landscape entirely sculpted by erosion
- The highest point in Cappadocia, **Uchisar Castle**, view this castle that is built on a hilltop overlooking the town
- The center of pottery skills that passed through generations and you will have a chance to see how pottery are made at Avanos Pottery Village
- Once a place for 15,000 Christian refugees, walk through the **Underground City** connected by 30km of corridors and passage ways \*Do note that you may need to squat to maneuver around

## Day 08 Cappadocia > Safranbolu

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

- Transfer to the UNESCO protected site, **Safranbolu**
- Go on a walking tour and explore the charm of what Safranbolu got to offer
- See the once famous bath house, **Cinci Hammam**, which had been restored

- Regarded as one of the most interesting mosque architecture, witness the beauty of **Koprulu Mehmet Pasa Mosque**
- A reminder of the town's importance as a stop on the trade route, **Cinci Han Caravanserai**, had been used by the merchants as a hotel
- Jam packed with many locally made craft work, spend some time at the **Safranbolu Bazaars Yemenciler Arastasi**

## Day 09 Safranbolu > Istanbul

### Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

- View the **Blue Mosque**, famous for its six minarets and its Iznik blue tiles
- An ancient square in Istanbul used for chariot racing, **Hippodrome**, is an Egyptian obelisk still standing today
- Do a quick photo stop at **Hagia Sophia Mosque**, an unique blend of Christianity and Islam religion
- Spend some time at the **Grand Bazaar**, one of the largest and oldest covered markets in the world

## Day 10 Istanbul

### Breakfast

- **Fener & Balat Neighbourhood**, not only it is an UNESCO Heritage site, it is also instagrammable
- Balat is Istanbul's most colourful and quaint neighbourhood so it comes as no surprise that it would have its own **Umbrella Street**
- **Istiklal Avenue**, a 1.4km street that runs from the Galata Tower all the way to Taksim Square
- Its time to shop at the **Istinye Park Mall** consisting of 291 stores with some high end brands such as Louis Vuitton and many more

## Day 11 Istanbul > Singapore

### Breakfast, Meals on board
