DAY 2 CHIANGMAI (B/L/D)

- **Long Neck Woman Village @ Ahka** - To visit their tribes and witness their unique culture.

DAY 3 CHIANGMAI - CHIANGRAI (B/L/D)

After breakfast, proceed to Chiangrai.

- **Hot-Spring Park** – You can buy some eggs to put into a basket attached to a long pole to hard-boil eggs in the boiling water.
- **Wat Rong Khun** - White Temple, a very Impressive Beautiful Ornate Delicate White Stuccowork Temple made and designed by a famous Thai artist Chalermchai Kositpipat.
- **Kuan Yin Temple**
- **Wat Rong Sear Tean** - Blue Temple
- **Baan Dam (Black House)** - Black House is a collection of wood architectures featuring works by Thawan Duchanee & other contemporary Thai artists.
- **Chiang Saen** – A former Capital of the First Thai Kingdom, situated on the Mekong River border between Thailand and Laos Proceed to Maesai.
- **Maesai** - This border town faces Myanmar across the Maesai River north of Chiangrai.
- **Golden Triangle** – Where the borderline of Thailand, Laos and Myanmar meet.

Optional Tour:

- Crossover Thailand border to Myanmar & a boat ride to Laos (If time permits)
